If we compare this paper with 1st May and last year papers then it is concluded that, Maths paper was equally divided with 11th and 12th class portions, but this paper was little tricky then the paper of 1st May. In Maths papers there were 3 questions which were only in AIEEE syllabus, so could be said difficult for the students who prepared for IIT-JEE only.

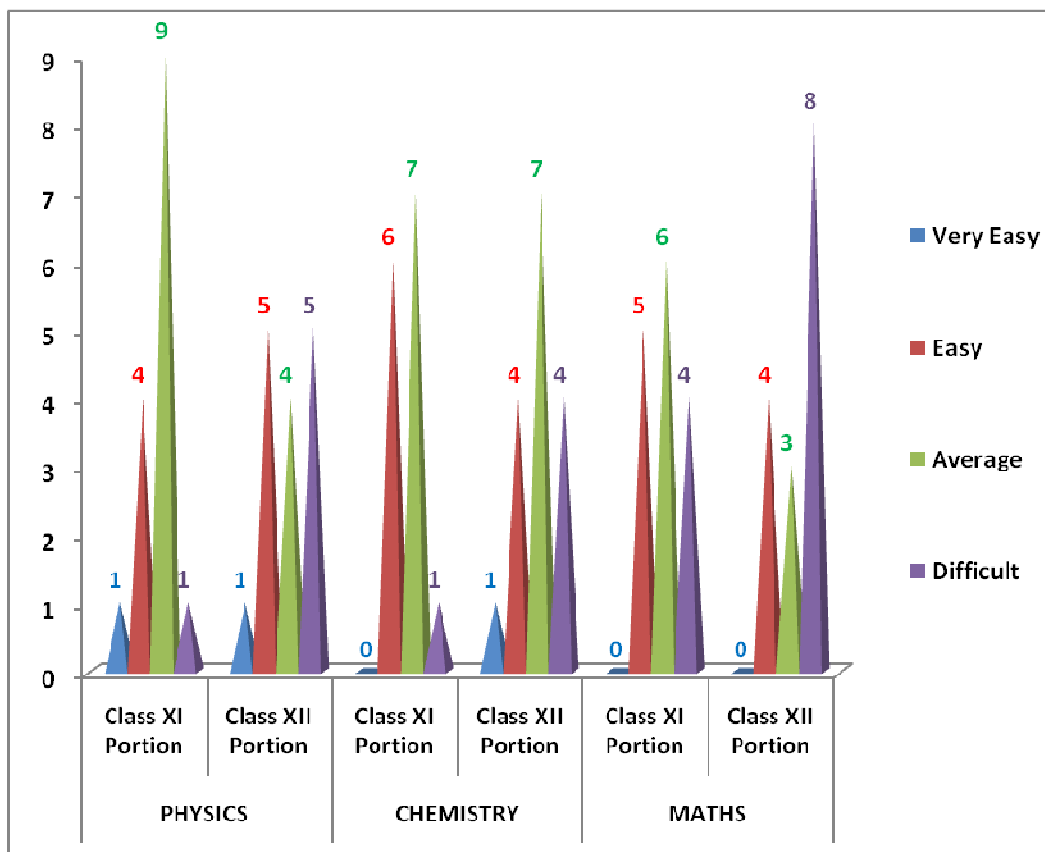
The Chemistry paper was also little tougher then the paper of 1st May but was easy if compared with last year paper, so it can be said that, those who appeared for the paper on 1st May must have felt the chemistry paper easy and were lucky too.

The Physics paper was also of equal weightage in class 11th and 12th portion, few of questions were easy in Mechanics and Electrodynamics and few of questions were difficult in Heat & Thermodynamics if compared with 1st May paper. Overall this physics paper was easy then the last year paper but had 2 questions of AIEEE syllabus only.

So finally we can say that, the 2nd paper of AIEEE was little tricky than the paper of 1st May 2011

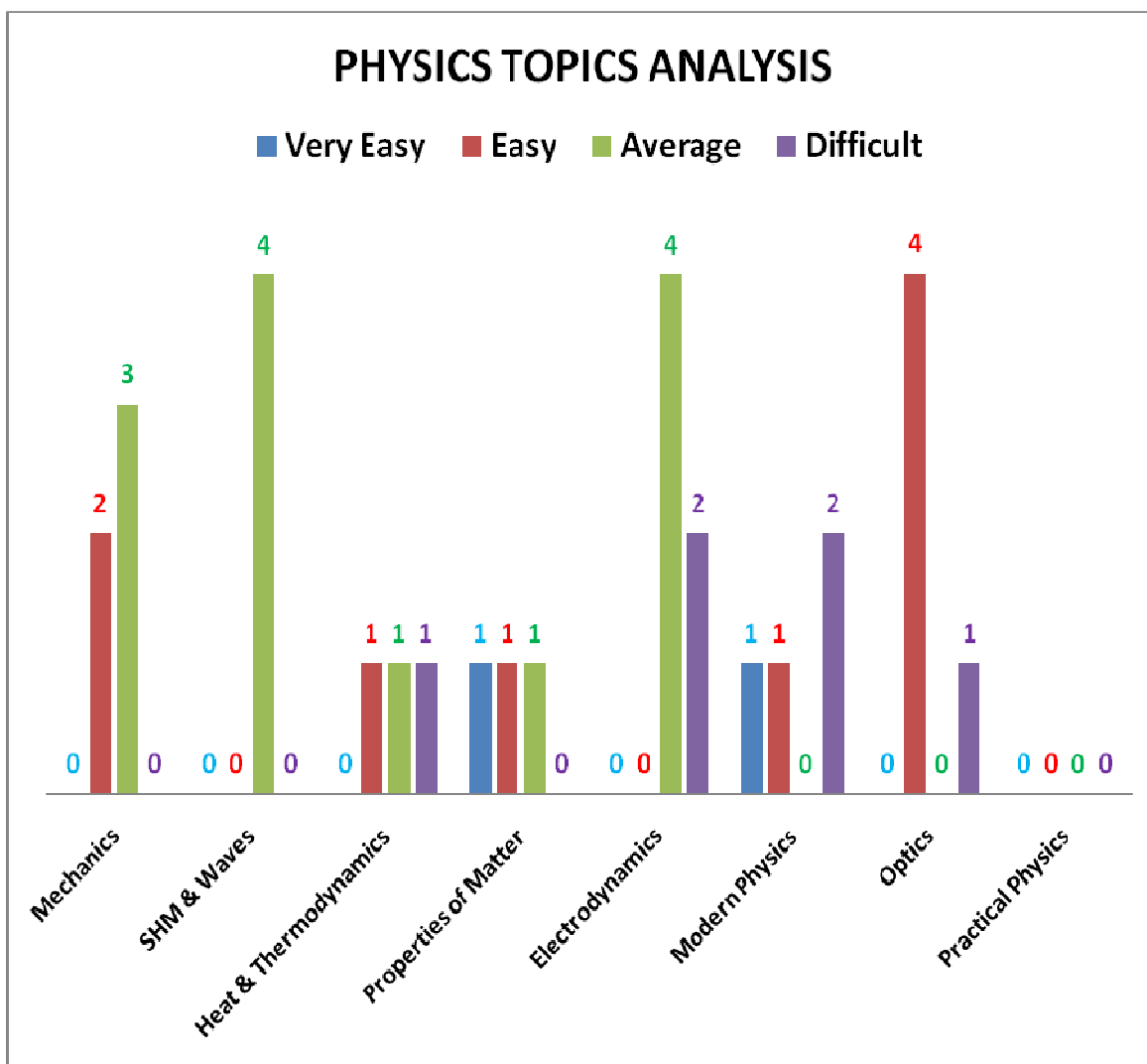
This graph shows the number of questions was in this paper from calss Xi and class XII syllabus on the basis of their difficulty level.



This table consists the the weightage of class Xi and class XII syllabus in P,C,M

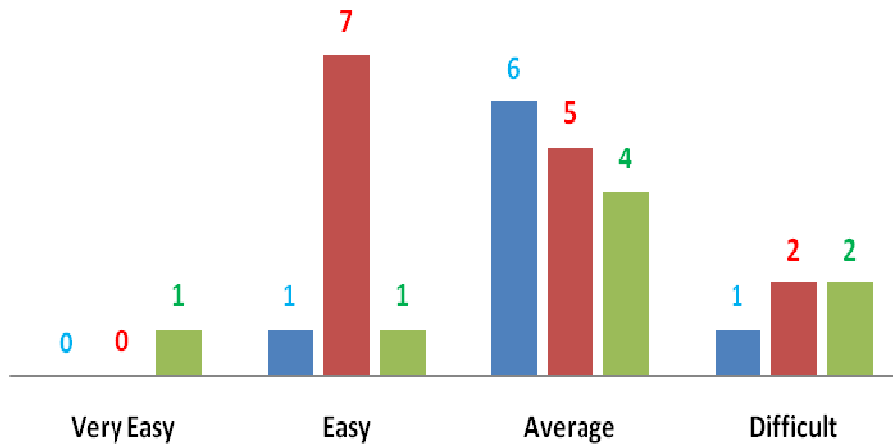
